The proposed installation is composed of a 63.0-meter self-support telecommunications tower, including the antennas and a lightning rod. Rogers will comply with marking and lighting requirements in accordance with Transport Canada protocols.

Objective: To improve wireless coverage in the vicinity of Williams Beach, Merville and along Highway 19.

Details: An equipment shelter will also be installed at the base of the proposed tower and the entire site will be surrounded by a security fence with a locked gated access point.

Existing tenure and operating intertidal aquaculture facility located in Fanny Bay, approximately at 49° 30' 2.95" N, 124° 47' 45.58" W, located on unsurveyed foreshore or land covered by water being part of the bed of Fanny Bay, fronting Blocks 28 and 30, Lot 149, Nanaimo District, in Fanny Bay, in the Province of British Columbia. Portions of this tenure are covered by clam protection netting.

Existing tenure and operating intertidal aquaculture facility located in Baynes Sound, approximately at 49° 30' 18" N, 124° 48' 17" W, located on unsurveyed foreshore or land covered by water being part of the bed of Fanny Bay in Baynes Sound, Block 29 of District Lot 149 and District Lot 2069, Nanaimo District, containing 8.734 hectares, more or less, in the Province of British Columbia. Portions of this tenure are covered by clam protection netting.
